Mike & Rachel Hill: OMF (Cambodia)

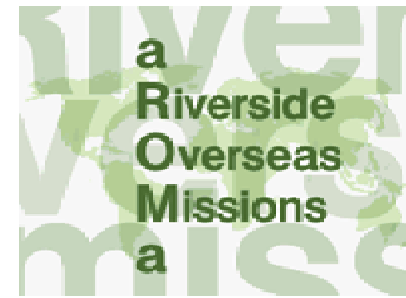
- Mission Kampuchea 2021, an interdenominational initiative to see a church in every village district by the year 2021.
